

## Preparation of an Extended Abstract for the ICONO'10 Conference

This is the abstract. This is an example of how a publication-ready contribution for ICONO'10 should look. The entire contribution must fit in two 8½ inch by 11” inch pages. You should use this document as a template and submit your abstract electronically as a Word OR as a pdf file. Your abstract will be duplicated and distributed to all conference participants, so the version you provide here must be of sufficient quality for reproduction. Please limit your abstract to no more than ten lines.

### Instructions

Here are the guidelines for creation of the extended (two-page) abstract, which constitute an example of how the extended abstract should look. The extended abstract must not exceed two pages in length. Use a 1-inch margin at top, bottom, left and right.

For the title, use a 14-pt font similar to Times New Roman, **bold**, and in title case.

Leave a blank line (14-pt line spacing) and begin with the author names, in no specific order (centered, 12-pt font similar to Times New Roman) and underline the presenting author as shown above. Follow this by their Institution(s) in *italics* as shown above. Leave a blank line (14-pt line spacing) before the abstract.

Type a short abstract, with full justification, within a rectangle that is 4¾” wide and centered horizontally. Use 10-pt font similar to Times New Roman. Leave a blank line (14-pt line spacing) after the abstract. Please limit your abstract to no more than ten lines.

Do not leave a blank line between paragraphs; indent them by 0.2 in instead. Use bold face text, left justified, for top-level section headers (as shown for the header labeled **Instructions**) leaving one empty line before them.

*Use italic text for second-level sections.*

There are no special requirements for Equations, Tables or Figures. Type Equations on separate lines, as in the following:

$$\exp(i\pi) + 1 = 0 \quad (1)$$

Use square brackets for references [1], and list them at the end of the document with the tab set at 0.3 in.

### Submitting your contribution

#### *Electronic Submission*

Electronic submissions are accepted using this Word template provided on our web page [2], but can be submitted in either Word OR pdf format.

All contributions must be submitted by January 31, 2008. Thank you for your careful preparation of the extended abstract.
